Psalm 34:1-8
New Revised Standard Version (NRSV)

- 1 I will bless the Lord at all times;
his praise shall continually be in my mouth.**
- 2 My soul makes its boast in the Lord;
let the humble hear and be glad.**
- 3 O magnify the Lord with me,
and let us exalt his name together.**
- 4 I sought the Lord, and he answered me
and delivered me from all my fears.**
- 5 Look to him, and be radiant,
so your faces shall never be ashamed.**
- 6 This poor soul cried and was heard by the Lord
and was saved from every trouble.**
- 7 The angel of the Lord encamps
around those who fear him and delivers them.**
- 8 O taste and see that the Lord is good;
happy are those who take refuge in him.**

Sermon Notes

The psalmist David declares that he will bless the Lord at all times – even in times of trouble! If anybody had a reason to become bitter, David did. But, he chose a different path, and so can we!
Here's how:

1) Adopt a Posture of _____.

“I will bless the Lord at all times; his praise shall continually be in my mouth.” – v. 1

2) Practice the Power of _____.

“I sought the Lord, and he answered me and delivered me from all my fears.” – v. 4

3) Claim the Promise of God's _____.

“O taste and see that the Lord is good; happy are those who take refuge in him.” – v. 8
