<sup>1</sup>O give thanks to the Lord, for he is good. for his steadfast love endures forever. <sup>2</sup>Let the redeemed of the Lord say so. those he redeemed from trouble <sup>3</sup> and gathered in from the lands. from the east and from the west. from the north and from the south. <sup>4</sup>Some wandered in desert wastes. finding no way to an inhabited town; <sup>5</sup> hungry and thirsty, their soul fainted within them. <sup>6</sup> Then they cried to the Lord in their trouble, and he delivered them from their distress: <sup>7</sup> he led them by a straight way, until they reached an inhabited town. <sup>8</sup>Let them thank the Lord for his steadfast love, for his wonderful works to humankind. <sup>9</sup> For he satisfies the thirsty, and the hungry he fills with good things.
