⁸ If I ascend to heaven, you are there;
if I make my bed in Sheol, you are there.
⁹ If I take the wings of the morning
and settle at the farthest limits of the sea,
¹⁰ even there your hand shall lead me,
and your right hand shall hold me fast.
¹¹ If I say, "Surely the darkness shall cover me,
and night wraps itself around me,"
¹² even the darkness is not dark to you;
the night is as bright as the day,
for darkness is as light to you.

On this Day of Pentecost, it is important for us to be reminded of the truth in the rhetorical question the psalmist asks – “Where can I go from your spirit?” The answer is nowhere!

Let us bring this closer to home and be more specific as we consider three key places where the psalmist tells God meets us:

1)The Dropping _____.

2)The Night That _____.

“Surely the darkness shall cover me, and night wraps itself around me”?

3)The Place Of _____.

“If I make my bed in Sheol, you are there.”
