FLOOD TASK FORCE UPDATE

When Munsey members organized the Hurricane Helene task force, the goal was to continue to respond to the needs well beyond the immediate needs of cleaning buckets and bottled water. As we wrap up our primary support of the six families who are part of the *Rebuild Embreeville* campaign, new opportunities are being explored. One such opportunity is to support the efforts of the Community Relief Aid Effort, a volunteer organization in Lancaster County (Pennsylvania) that provides disaster assistance throughout the US. A volunteer group is currently based in Limestone, TN and is providing work teams (who volunteer for a 2-week commitment) throughout the spring. Trish Patterson and Cheryl Maner went grocery shopping with two of the current volunteer group, Becky and Mary Ann, this past week. The Flood Task Force will continue to provide this service for the next 4 months and invites volunteers to help. On the last night of the group's stay, they reflect and share their thoughts on what they accomplished and their overall experience.
