TODAY'S SERMON:

"The Mystery of Holy Communion"

Scripture: St. Luke 22:14-20
(New Revised Standard Version)

- v. 14** When the hour had come, Jesus sat down, and the twelve apostles with him.
- v. 15** Then he said to them, "With great desire I have wanted to eat this Passover with you before My time of suffering;
- v. 16** for I say to you, I will not eat of it again until the kingdom of God is fulfilled."
- v. 17** Then He took the cup, and gave thanks, and said, "Take this and share it with one another;
- v. 18** for I say to you, I will not drink of the fruit of the vine until the kingdom of God comes."
- v. 19** And He took bread, gave thanks and broke it, and gave it to them, saying, "This is My body which is given for you; do this in remembrance of Me."
- v. 20** Likewise He also took the cup after they ate, saying, "This cup is the new covenant of My blood, which is shed for you.
